## **VOLUNTEER SPOTLIGHT | RISING TO THE OCCASION**

In our ongoing efforts to tackle the hunger crisis, it is noteworthy to share that many clients served by the GVFB have been in Canada for less than two years. With English being a second language for most newcomers, it often poses communication challenges, particularly during the registration process to access food bank services.

Fortunately, individual food distribution volunteers like Andy Fung are pivotal in supporting the GVFB team by translating Chinese into English. Here's what Andy had to say in his role as a Volunteer Interpreter:



"Many GVFB clients do not speak English well and need language assistance. As a volunteer at the Vancouver Distribution site, I have interpreted for Cantonesespeaking clients when they have general questions or when GVFB staff needs information from clients for registration.

After helping clients break through the language barrier, clients always reward me with warm smiles and heartfelt thank yous. I am grateful that I can help clients with interpretation, in addition to my regular food distribution duties."

The Distribution Interpreter will provide direct translation support during registration and update interviews. Required skills and responsibilities include:

- Must be a minimum of 18 years old.
- Fluent in speaking English and able to comprehend instructions in English.
- Proficient in Cantonese and Mandarin.
- Providing direct and neutral interpretation of sensitive conversations between staff and clients.
